Steven P. Erie, Ph.D. will speak about Southern California's public-private ventures, oil, rail power and the "heavy-lifting" of regional power brokers who began shaping the critical turning points of port and civic development in Long Beach and Los Angeles more than a century ago.

The author of the award-winning book, **Globalizing L.A.: Trade, Infrastructure, and Regional Development**, Erie is one of the region's most prolific and sought after researchers and writers, actively involved in state and regional public policy debates concerning infrastructure, economic development, governance, and public finance. He has been a consultant to the Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation, the Orange County Business Council, the Southern California Association of Governments, and RAND. Erie frequently contributes op/ed articles on policy issues to the Los Angeles Times, San Diego Union-Tribune and other newspapers.

Recently, he has researched Southern California trade infrastructure and regional development for the California Policy Research Center, the Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation, the Orange County Business Council, the Pacific Council on International Policy, and San Diego Dialogue. Currently, he is studying regional airport governance for the Southern California Association of Governments.
